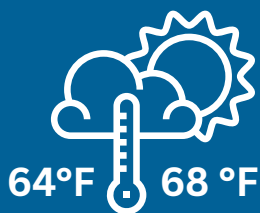

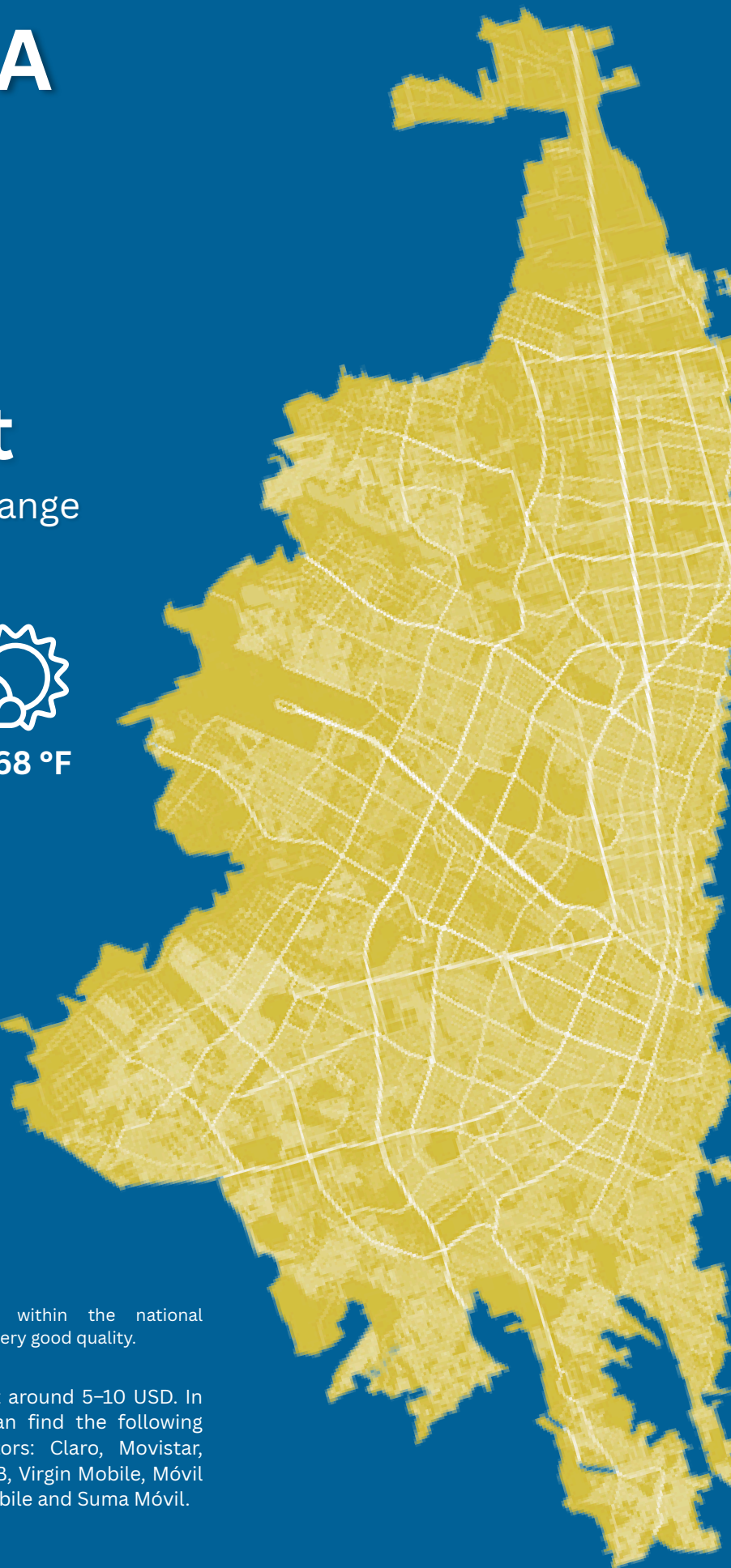

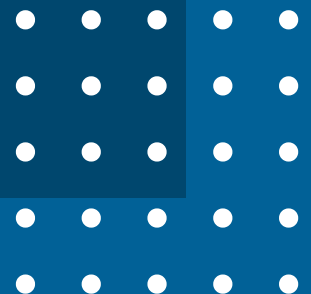

- The currency used in Colombia is the Colombian peso. Within the city, debit and credit cards, as well as cash, are accepted payment methods.
- It is recommended to activate international cards before arriving in the country.



# VEN Y DESCÚBRE BOGOTÁ

The La Candelaria neighbourhood is your guide to the city's most historic area. Its streets and infrastructure evoke the city's colonial times, and to this day, its preserved houses and buildings feature colonial balconies, corridors and interior courtyards.



## Plazoleta Chorro de Quevedo

Considered the birthplace of Bogotá. This place, where the city began in 1539, is now a popular destination for locals and visitors alike, bringing together musicians, artists and storytellers celebrating the city's culture.

## Bolívar Square

Dating back to the founding of the city, it is one of the most famous public spaces in the country, becoming the cultural and civic centre of Colombia.



## Monserate

The natural and spiritual symbol of the nation's capital, an iconic place waiting to be discovered. It is located 3,152 metres above sea level and boasts one of the most important and iconic churches in the country.



## Graffiti Tours

La Candelaria is a canvas for many talented graffiti artists who express the spirit and art of the city. Murals full of history and intention.



## Gold Museum

In pre-Hispanic times, Colombia was home to diverse indigenous societies. Much of their artistic legacy is preserved at the Gold Museum, which houses 34,000 gold pieces and 20,000 objects made from other materials.



## Botero Museum

Fernando Botero is one of Colombia's most celebrated artists. His style, known as Boterismo, depicts people and animals with exaggerated proportions and volumes.

## Cycling Routes

The **highest number of daily bike trips** in the region, with approximately **600 kilometres** of cycling infrastructure, making it an excellent transport option.



## Ecological Walks

To disconnect from the daily routine, the city offers spots like **Quebrada Las Delicias, La Aguadora, Usaquén, Páramo de Sumapaz and Parque Simón Bolívar.**

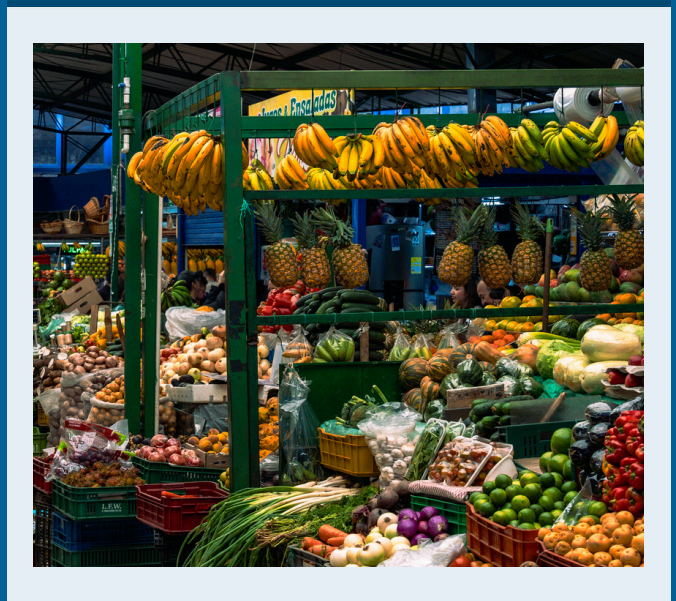

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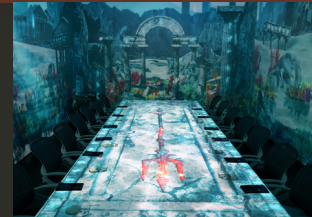
